Each institution will submit the name of its leading candidate to the Chancellor's liaison to the USMSC no later than close of business on Wednesday, November 28, 2007. All candidates will be invited to interview with the USMSC at their regular meeting on December 9, 2007 at the University of Maryland, Baltimore County, beginning at 12:00 noon. Following that meeting, the USMSC will convey the names of their top three candidates to the Chancellor. The Chancellor and his senior staff will interview the top candidates in late December or early January, and the Chancellor will forward three names to the Governor prior to the start of the 2008 legislative session.
